## Owl Monitoring Program

Secondary (Gr 7 to Post Secondary)

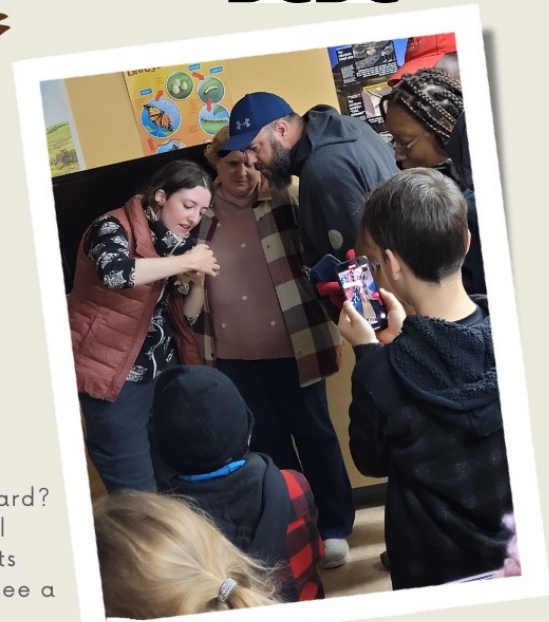
Science 7, 9, 10, Bio 20, Bio 30

Location: Boreal Centre for Bird Conservation

Program: Approx. 2 hours

Did you know that exciting owl research is happening in your own backyard? Every fall, the Lesser Slave Lake Bird Observatory operates their Fall Owl Migration Program to learn more about owls in the boreal forest. Students will interact with our owl researchers and hopefully have the chance to see a tiny Northern Saw-whet Owl up close. This popular interactive program introduces students to the results of our owl research, owl ecology and their unique adaptations, owl species of Alberta and may include an owl banding demonstration if we catch one for you. Program is weather dependent.

**Note: This program only runs during September and October**



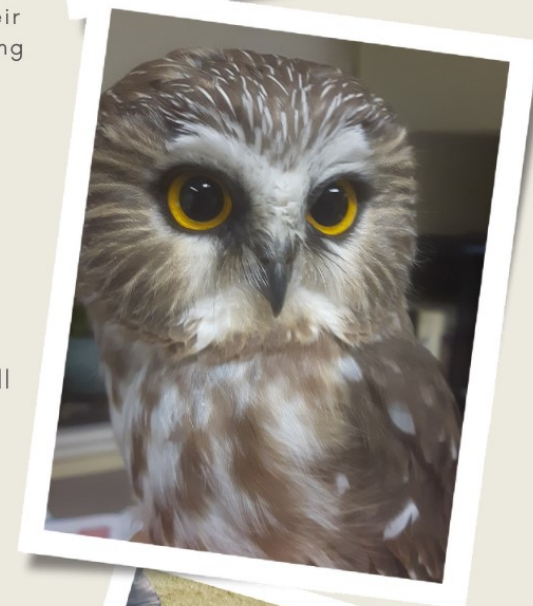
## Owl Classroom Program

Elementary (Gr 1-6)-Living Systems, Earth Systems

Secondary (Gr 7 - 12): Science 7,9,19, Bio 20, Bio 30

Program: 60 minutes.

Can't bring your class out to the Boreal Centre, then invite us into your classroom. Although we can't bring a live owl to see you, our educators will provide an interactive program with a fun introduction to the world of owls, and our LSLBO research programs.



## Boreal Forest survivor

Gr 3 to 12


Program: Minimum 90 minutes, but can be easily adapted

Fall is a great time of year to test out your Boreal Forest survival skills. This hands-on outdoor program can include what to do if you are ever lost, shelter building, fire lighting with flint and steel and bushcraft skills. Add a nature hike to make the most of your trip to the Boreal Centre. This program can be easily adapted into a full day fieldtrip for your students
