Just choose the bird you like and fill out the necessary information on both sides of the form. Then mail to the LSLBO.

- Yellow-rumped Warbler** \$20.00
 This is the number one bird that we band at our research lab.
- American Redstart** \$30.00
 The males of this common warbler are a dramatic black with bright red patches.
- White-throated Sparrow** \$40.00
 This bird has one of the most memorable songs of the boreal forest, "Oh Sweet Canada, Canada, Canada."
- Yellow Warbler** \$50.00
 This bird is a bright yellow all over and the males have a red-streaked breast.
- Black-capped Chickadee** \$50.00
 "Chick-a-dee-dee-dee" is just one of the recognizable vocalizations of this bird.
- Black-and-white Warbler** \$60.00
 This warbler is usually among the first spring migrants to arrive.
- Sharp-shinned Hawk** \$70.00
 Although too large for our nets, we catch these small predators as they hunt the migrating songbirds in the forest.
- Canada Warbler** \$80.00
 Help support our special research project to learn more about this beautiful boreal warbler.
- Northern Saw-whet Owl** \$100.00
 You can sponsor one of these special owls that are banded during the Northern Saw-whet Owl Fall Monitoring program.

HOW CAN I ADOPT A BOREAL BIRD?

It is easy, just choose the type of bird that you would like to adopt from our list of birds that are banded at the Lesser Slave Lake Bird Observatory. Then fill out the form and send it to the LSLBO. The adoptee will receive an adoption certificate featuring:

- A colour picture of the adopted bird which was banded at the LSLBO
- Certificate details of the bird's band number, age, sex, weight and wing span, as well as some general information on its range and habits.
- If your bird is ever recaptured, we will contact you with the details of the recovery so that you can track its progress.
